Policy Statement:

This policy shall provide guidelines for the appropriate management of cardiac/respiratory arrest or other medically emergent situations in the Texas Tech Physicians of El Paso (TTP-EP) ambulatory clinics.

Scope and Distribution:

This policy applies to all Texas Tech Physicians of El Paso clinics.

Procedure:

- 1. In the event of a cardio-pulmonary arrest or other life-threatening emergency, the clinical personnel should:
 - a. Initiate Basic Life Support and/or appropriate emergency treatment (A-B-C's) or as ordered by the physician. Call 911 to activate EMS.
 - b. Designate a person to obtain needed supplies or equipment and another to record interventions and patient assessments to eventually document them in the EMR.
 - c. Notify the Texas Tech Police to direct the EMS to the patient.
 - d. Assist the EMS team to prepare the patient for transport to the nearest emergency department.
 - e. An occurrence report should be completed as required by policy EP 8.4, Occurrence Reporting.
- Minor medical emergencies not requiring immediate referral to the Emergency Department may be treated by medical personnel within the TTP-EP clinics at the discretion of the physician and consent of the patient.
