#### What is Canvas?

- TTUHSC El Paso online course management system
- Learning Management Platform
  - Web-based system
- Tool for teachers, professors, and staff developers
  - Create online courses or online training.

### Canvas for IFDC

Online courses intended for IFDC participants who are interested in obtaining:

- Continuing Medical Education (CME) credit
  - Credit towards their IFDC requirements
  - Non-IFDC participants can request to do the courses (available upon request)
- Non-CME credit
  - Credit towards their IFDC requirements
  - Non-IFDC participants can request to do the courses (available upon request)

#### Canvas for IFDC cont.

#### Online Learning Presentation Project

- Advance the participants' ability to create online educational material.
- Due date: Feb. 14, 2020, for IFDC
  - Due date to provide material to Lead Analysts: Friday, January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020
- Feedback will be provided on April 1, 2020

## Online Learning Presentation Requirements

- Cover a discipline/specialty-specific topic or simulation-based learning activity, different from the one for oral presentation.
- Title page
  - Presentation Title:
  - Presenter's Name:
  - Degree:
  - Affiliation and Institution:
- List two learning objectives

## Online Learning Presentation Requirements cont.

- Create five (5) pretest items to assess the learners' knowledge before the content presentation.
- Create five (5) post-test items different from the pretests items.
- Items can be written in a Word Document or inside the PPT.

## Online Learning Presentation Requirements cont.

- Narrated PPT (a 10-minute educational video using a predefined, institutional template to follow the pretest)
- FDC participants who will be creating a simulation module/course should develop and assess a "criterion checklist" for the simulated procedure.
  - Acceptable performance steps in a procedure.
  - The quality or degree of excellence of the steps performed.

## Online Learning Presentation Requirements cont.

- Conclusions/Summary of the content
- Literature
- The corresponding author's contact information
- A one-to-two page PDF handout summarizing the take-home messages, notes, recommended readings, links, and additional information.


