PURPOSE: To demonstrate the GMEC's effective oversight of program performance

POLICY STATEMENT: The GMEC has established metrics for program performance.

Significant program deficiencies may qualify a program for a Special

Review as determined by the GMEC.

PROCEDURE(S): The GMEC will monitor program performance based on the following

indicators. Programs will report to the GMEC, on a quarterly basis, any action plans to correct yellow or red indicators.* After review of the performance indicators, the GMEC may determine if a Special Review should be conducted. The GMEC will review program performance

indicators to determine if a focused review is needed.
