PURPOSE: To establish a policy that outlines the process and documentation

developed for resident/fellow verification of active Texas Medical Board

(TMB) Permit or Licensure status.

POLICY/PROCEDURE STATEMENT: The following process serves as means for verification of permit or licensure status via electronic search and review from the original source.

- 1. The GME office will verify currently active permits/licenses on a quarterly basis by accessing the TMB webpage and performing individual searches for all active residents/fellows.
- 2. Every residents'/fellows' verification will be logged on a spreadsheet and kept in an electronic file.
- 3. If there are no issues found, no further action will be taken.
- 4. If an issue is discovered, the GME office will contact the Program Director to review the issue and to work on an action plan.
- 5. Verification results will be reported at the GMEC meeting following completion of verification.

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
