PURPOSE: To outline the stipulations for the appointment of residents and/or fellows in

programs of graduate medical education.

POLICY STATEMENT: The Texas Tech University health Sciences Center – El Paso Paul L. Foster School of Medicine shall appoint trainees based on the following criteria:

- 1. Each prospective appointee should be eligible for licensure in the state of Texas and to take national board examinations for specialty board certification.
- 2. Each prospective appointee shall have passed Steps 1 and Step 2 of the appropriate licensing examination within the number of attempts indicated by the Texas Medical Board for Texas licensure.
- 3. Each prospective appointee shall have submitted the results of a criminal background check that establishes he/she is eligible for clinical training in accordance with HSC OP 10.20, "Criminal Background Checks for Students, Trainees and Residents".
