Email the 2 completed forms as attachments to Diane Huerta in the Department of Emergency Medicine at diane.huerta@ttuhsc.edu by 10:00am, January 31, 2019. This is a firm date. No submissions will be accepted after the deadline.

1. The primary author/presenter must register for the conference.
2. If submitting a **research abstract**, it should contain:
 - a. A short and descriptive title
 - b. A concise statement about the problem under investigation or the hypothesis to be tested
 - c. A concise statement about the experimental method used
 - d. The essential results obtained (specific findings must be included; broad generalizations or the promise "to be completed" are not acceptable) in summary form
 - e. Conclusions
3. If submitting a **case report**, it should contain:
 - a. A short and descriptive title
 - b. Case presentation
 - c. Discussion
4. Abstracts will be accepted for presentation on the basis of the merit of the data presented in the abstract and will be notified February 15th. ***Incomplete or improperly executed abstracts will be rejected.*** A panel of reviewers will score all submitted abstracts and the top abstracts will be presented on March 27-28 during conference breaks. The decision of the Program and Planning Committee regarding accepted and rejected abstracts is final.
