Operating Policy and Procedure

HSCEP OP 61.27: Freedom of Expression

DATE: October 1, 2019

PURPOSE: Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center El Paso (TTUHSCEP) recognizes freedom of speech and expression as a fundamental right and seeks to ensure free, robust, and uninhibited debate and deliberation by students enrolled at TTUHSCEP as well as other persons. The purpose of this Operating Policy/Procedure (HSCEP OP) is to ensure the fundamental right of freedom of speech and expression on the TTUHSCEP campus.

REVIEW: This HSCEP OP will be reviewed in July of odd-numbered years by the Senior Director of Safety, Managing Director for Building Maintenance and Operations, Assistant Vice President of Student Services, Texas Tech University System Office of General Counsel, and Chief of Police (or their designee(s)), with recommendations for revision submitted to the Chief Financial Officer by August 1.
