TTUHSC EL PASO FIRE RESPONSE PROCEDURE

Departmental Unit Safety Officers are required to review fire response procedures with department employees at least once each year and/or have employees complete emergency fire response training online. Confirmation of this training should be sent to the Safety Services office using the NESOP Level 2 form available to Unit Safety Officers.

The following items must be reviewed with faculty and staff in the department:

- 1. Correct fire emergency response including:
 - a. RACE procedure
 - i. **Rescue** persons in danger
 - ii. Activate the fire alarm system
 - iii. Contain fire by closing doors
 - iv. **Evacuate** to a safe area
 - b. Pull station locations
 - c. Phone numbers to call
 - d. Primary and secondary evacuation routes and the location of the assigned meeting area
- 2. Patient and visitor movement
- 3. Fire Drills
- 4. Fire Extinguishers (See Attachment D)
 - a. Location
 - b. Types
 - c. Proper Use
 - i. Training
 - ii. PASS procedure
