ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

GPA

- A minimum of 3.0 cumulative and science GPA is required to apply.

PREREQUISITES

- A minimum of 44 credit hours of prerequisites (including all four lab sciences), completed at the time of application.

HESI ASSESSMENT

- A HESI cumulative score of 80% or higher is recommended for competitive applicants; special emphasis is placed on the HESI Science composite score.
- HESI exam must be dated within one year of application.

- Complete the Hunt School of Nursing application.**
Please allow 24-48 hours for an invitation to the secondary application.
- Complete your FAFSA.**

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When and how will I know a decision has been made on my application?

Applicants will be notified via email within 8-10 weeks after the application deadline. Please monitor your application status through the Hunt School of Nursing Portal.

How many HESI attempts are students allowed?

The HESI Admission Assessment can be taken twice within a calendar year. Contact Elsevier Evolve for questions regarding registration. Please submit your official HESI Admissions Score Report with your secondary application.

Where do I submit my transcripts when applying?

Submit official transcripts from all institutions attended to NursingCAS when applying. Transcripts must be sent with sufficient time; please allow 2-4 weeks for processing. Visit nursingcas.org for more information.
